

Captain Jeremy M. Lukowski distinguished himself by meritorious achievement while participating in sustained aerial flight as an F-16 Pilot, 34th Fighter Squadron, 388th Fighter Wing, Hill Air Force Base, Utah from 25 May 2002 to 1 April 2003. During this period, the airmanship and courage exhibited by Captain Lukowski provided continuous fighter assets for air patrols in support of Operation NOBLE EAGLE. His unwavering dedication to duty was instrumental in assisting the North American Aerospace Defense Command Region to continue to secure the borders of North America following the 11 September 2001 terrorist attacks. In addition, Captain Lukowski was vital in providing twenty-four hours a day and seven days a week aerial coverage for the President of the United States and National Capital Region. His efforts were key in the squadron's successful completion of 636 sorties, totaling over three thousand flying hours. The professional ability and outstanding aerial accomplishments of Captain Lukowski reflect great credit upon himself and the United States Air Force.
