ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Captain Jeremy M. Lukowski distinguished himself by meritorious service as Chief of Scheduling and F-16 Pilot, 80th Fighter Squadron, 8th Operations Group, 8th Fighter Wing, Kunsan Air Base, Republic of Korea. During this period, Captain Lukowski expertly coordinated and scheduled the squadron's 19 million dollar 2005 flying hour program to include aircraft, airspace, and annual training requirements for 32 operational F-16 pilots. His flawless efforts ensured accurate accountability for nearly 3,800 operational F-16 sorties and over 5,100 flying hours resulting in a 100 percent combat mission ready status. As Chief of Safety, Captain Lukowski's aggressive safety programs directly contributed to zero class A, B, or C flying mishaps in the squadron during his tenure. His recurring safety inspections and timely mishap notification program were the keys behind this outstanding squadron safety record. He was hand-picked to lead six large force employment sorties achieving a phenomenal 100 percent hit rate. In addition, his flight leadership skills contributed to an astounding 96 percent hit rate during the 2005 Pacific Air Forces Operational Readiness Inspection and the wing's overall "Excellent" rating. The distinctive accomplishments of Captain Lukowski reflect credit upon himself and the United States Air Force.
